ATTENDANCE

Truancy – Unexcused absences and the courts.

Denial of Credit – When you miss more than 10% of class, regardless of the reason and the grade in the class.

1st Semester – 7 absences per class; denial of credit on 8

2nd Semester – 9 absences per class; denial of credit on 10.

* It is your responsibility to keep up with your attendance.

**If you missed class, you missed work. Go to tutoring!!

Attendance Office –

- Turn in excuse notes within 3 days of an absence.
- Provide reports

Attendance Committee –

- Contracts to make up time if passing the class and have missed < 25% of the semester
- Make up time in tutoring or Saturday School

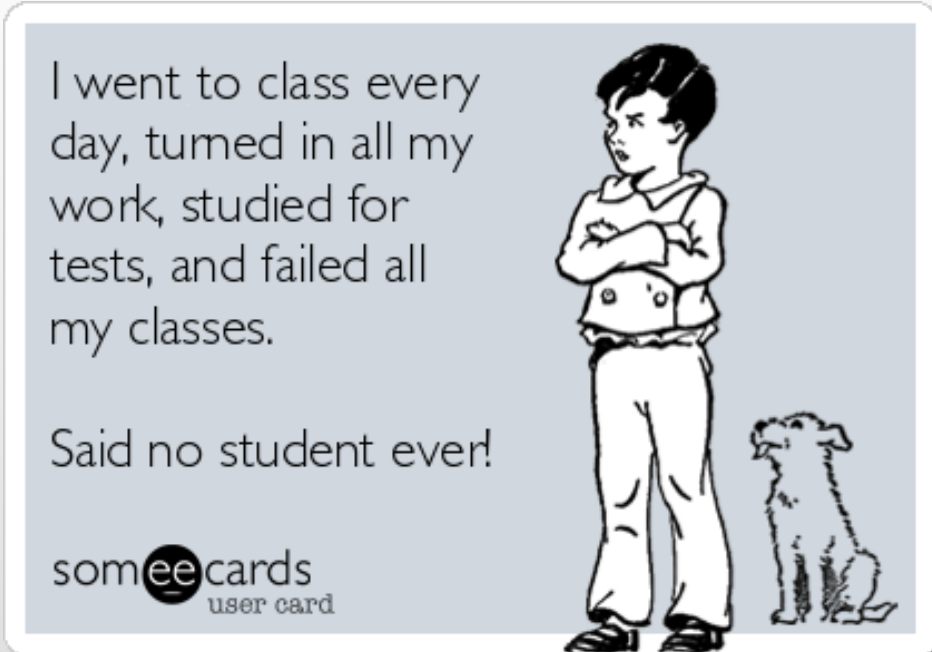
